# School that was failing has turned around in just two years, says report

AN ERDINGTON school that was taken under council con-trol because of its poor results has completely reversed its fortunes within two years, an Ofsted inspection revealed this week

Inspectors who visited Stockland Green School in November gave it a glowing report, judging it to be 'good' and rapidly improving with 'outstanding' features.

The news comes two years after the school was made a National Challenge school, which applied to establish-ments where the number of pupils gaining five GCSEs was

no higher than 30 per cent.
The school received a funding boost and a federation was set up with Arthur Terry School in Sutton, sharing staff and governors from the school under the guidance of Arthur

Terry head, Chris Stone.
Since then GCSE results have tripled as the school has from strength strength.

Inspectors noted that "strong senior leadership is ensuring that well thought out



strategies for improvement

are having a positive impact."

Inspectors also noted that in

terms of governance, partner-ships and equality, the school was outstanding.
